SPECIFICATIONS FOR 8'STUDWOOD -- 2010/2011

ALL PURCHASED STUDWOOD MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING STANDARDS:

- 1) The stud wood must have a top diameter of not less than 4.1\2" inside bark and a maximum butt diameter of 20".
- 2) The length must be 100" long or more, not less.
- 3) The stud wood must be sound with no rotten butts or stained wood in load.
- 4) No dead wood in load.
- 5) Delimbed properly with knots cut flush with the bolt, no spikes, butt flair or forks will be allowed.
- 6) Acceptable species are: Spruce, Fir, & Jack Pine. Cow pasture spruce is usually not acceptable for the stud wood grade because of quality.
- 7) No cross sticks, brush, mud or other foreign objects in the load.
- 8) Stud wood evidently over 3 months old will be rejected.

WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTABLE?

- Wood less than 100"
- Wood under 4.1\2" or over 20" at the butt
- Wood with double forks
- Crooked wood
- Piece with excessive knots
- Dead wood
- Split butt from cutter or harvester (barber chair)
